## Date

We did make progress toward this goal, although Jimmy was frustrated because the white crayon did not show up on the white paper. It helped to put the other colors in the clouds. He eventually was able to complete several clouds to fill the sky. Overall, the class went well. The students listened to the story. Like Jimmy, many were frustrated by the white crayon on the white paper but were able to make some clouds. To make this lesson more productive for my student, it might be better to save the white crayon for last and to begin instead with a cloud color that shows up.
